

eDressage - RULES

ANY BREACH OF THE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE TEST NOT BEING JUDGED OR YOU MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR BEING PLACED OR GETTING POINTS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE (but your entry fee will not be returned).

WHAT TO WEAR

1. Smart attire should be worn.
2. Riding HATS must be worn with suitable footwear with a heel.
3. GLOVES must be worn.
4. BD legal whips and Spurs may be worn.

WHAT YOUR HORSE/PONY SHOULD WEAR

1. Saddle and snaffle bridles and BD legal nose bands.
2. BD legal bits only. NO BITGUARDS.
3. Balancing straps (on the front of the saddle) and neck straps may be worn.
4. Martingales grass, side, draw or elasticated reins may not be used.
5. Dressage legal ear covers may be worn.
6. No exercise sheets.

HOW TO VIDEO

1. The person with the video must stand behind C zooming in at the A end. Try to keep the rider in the centre of the picture. if using a smart phone the landscape mode must be used.
2. The 20m x40m arena must be marked out with the correct measurements and markers, whether on grass or in a school.
3. The test MUST be clearly verbally introduced by the person doing the video or a reader at the beginning of the test with the horse and riders name and the date.
4. The video MUST have sound.
5. The video must have no cuts and should start at least 4 seconds before the riders enters the arena and after the salute at the end.
6. The test CAN be called but there should be NO training advice to the rider.
7. Copyright laws must be adhered to when submitting any video footage or other printed material. WSRC will not be liable for any costs incurred as a result of a competitor or 3rd party causing infringement of the copyright laws.

GENERAL RULES

1. Videos of tests must not have been judged in any other competition including e dressage.
2. Horse and rider combinations may not compete in tests more than one level apart.
3. WSRC take no responsibility for any injury that may occur to horse and/or rider whilst recording the video.
4. Any rider under the age of 16 must have parental consent.
5. Entries will be open until 23.59 hours on the day specified. Videos will not be accepted after that date and no refunds will be given once the entries have been made.

ENTRIES

On entering any of the classes with the WSRC, you accept and abide by the rules and terms and conditions. Non members must reside in the UK and the WSRC reserve the right to refuse an entry without stating a reason.
